

READY GOLF TIP SHEET

Tee Box

- Proceed to tee box area when the starter calls your foursome “on deck”. Be ready with your glove on; ball, tee and club out.
- Gold tee players should park in the first parking position.
- The player who is ready should hit first.
- Tee off as soon as the group ahead is cleared.
- Carry an extra ball in your pocket.

Fairway

- Hit when ready and safe. Using the honors system is not always necessary.
- Take the appropriate club(s) to your ball and get ready to hit. Set up while your partners are hitting.
- Limit search for lost balls to THREE minutes.

Green

- Park your cart ahead, toward the next tee box. Walk back to the green or your ball.
- Study your putt while others are putting.
- If appropriate, continue putting until holed out.
- Leave the green immediately, record your score and place your clubs in the bag at the next tee.

General Tips

- When you are driving, drop your partner at their ball and proceed to yours or park between the two.
- Stay within one shot of the group in front of you.
- If you are undecided or on a cart path only hole, take more than one club with you rather than walking back to the cart to get another.
- Watch your ball until it stops rolling to reduce time spent looking.
- Watch everyone’s tee shot to assist in ball location.
